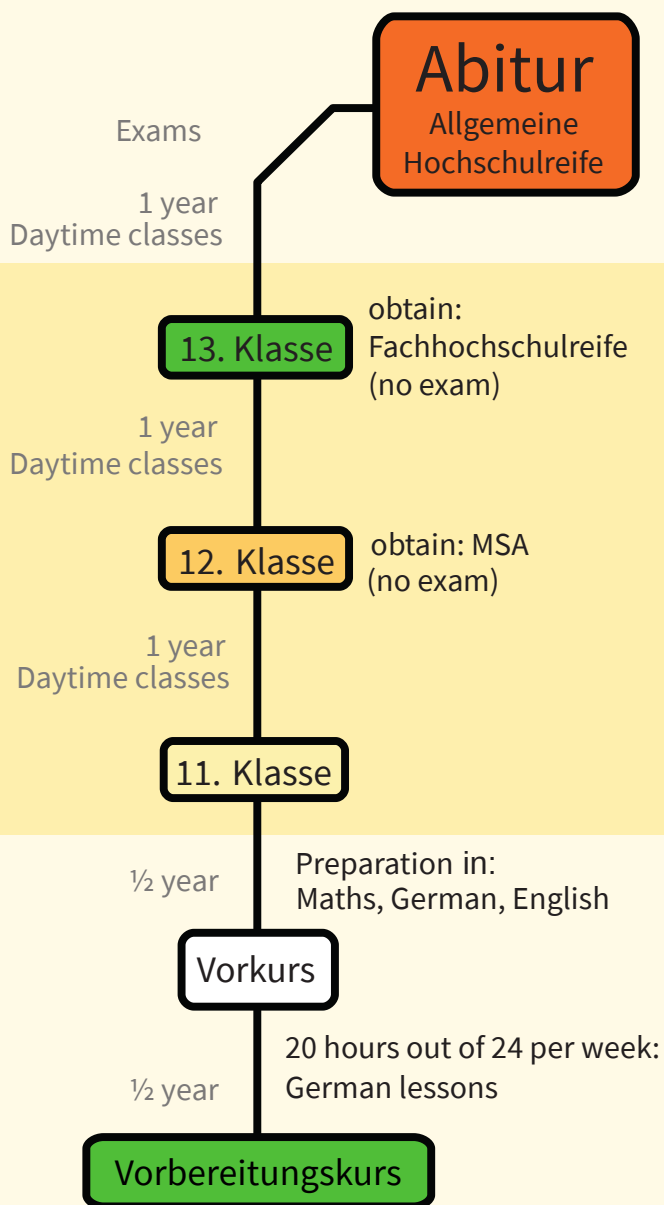


Your path to “Abitur”
